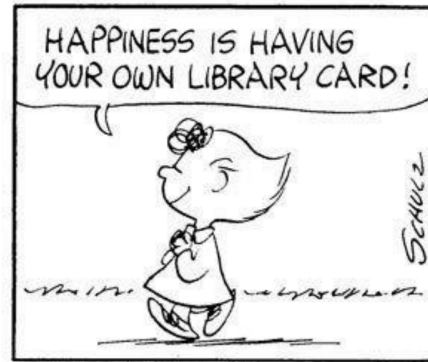

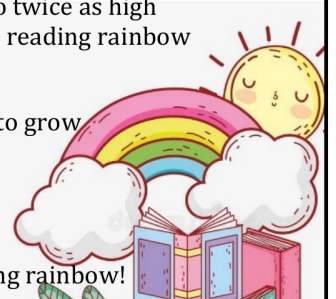
### Reading Rainbow
