


How to Save a Quizlet Quiz

*** Using Google Chrome as your browser is the best choice ***

- Follow the link from the resources section of the science webpage to get to the Quizlet quizzes.
- Once you take the quiz and score an 80% or higher, you need to save it. You can do it one of two ways.

1. Save a picture of what you did in Google drive by clicking the Google Drive button (in Chrome only)




A dialog box will show you that it's loading to your drive. Once it's done loading, click "Close" on the dialog box.

2. If you don't have the Google drive button, you can also save this using the print function

Click the "Print this test Button"



This will bring up a dialog box that looks like this:



Instead of printing, you'll save it by clicking the "Change" button and selecting "Save as PDF"

Once you click "Save" it will prompt you to select a location. This is where you pick your documents folder so you can retrieve it later. Click "ok." Voila! You're done!
