Earthworm Dissection Guideline

- 1. Observe the external features first
- 2. Count the number of segments between the mouth and the clitellum.
- 3. Measure the length of your worm from mouth to anus in cm.
- 4. Place a pin through the mouth
- 5. Place a second pin behind the clitellum
- **6.** Make a like cut behind the clitellum. (**Not To Hard**)
- 7. Take the scissors and lift and cut the top layer of skin (Cut about 2cm)
- 8. Pin open the layers of skin
- 9. Continue cutting and keep lifting first all the way to the mouth
- 10. Pin apart the skin so you can see clearly inside of the earthworm
- 11. Draw what you see inside and label
 - a. Aortic Arches
 - b. Esophagus
 - c. Crop
 - d. Gizzard
 - e. Seminal Vesicles
 - f. Intestine or Gut
- 12. If there is time left cut a slice of the worm below the clitellum
- 13. Place it on a slide and draw a cross section of what you see
- 14. Label the following parts
 - a. Epidermis
 - b. Muscles
 - c. Blood vessel
 - d. Gut
 - e. Coelom

Answer the following questions:

- 1. Do the segments refer to how old the earthworm is?
- 2. What is one thing that you thought was interesting about the external structure of the earthworm?
- 3. What is the job of the crop?
- 4. What is the job of the gizzard?
- 5. What is one thing that you thought was interesting about the internal structure of the earthworm?
