Goggle Use

- Wear goggles when using:
 - Chemicals
 - Sharp objects
 - Fire
- NON-NEGOTIABLE
- It's a LAW!






- Fire hazard
 - Use goggles
 - Tie back long hair
 - Tie back loose clothing




Electrical

- Electrical Hazard
 - Watch for water
 - Be aware of cords




Poison

- Poison Hazard
 - Wear goggles
 - Read label
 - Keep away from mouth



Harmful


- Harmful Chemical
 - Similar to toxic,
 but less
 dangerous
 - Keep away from mouth
 - Wear goggles
 - Read label



HARMFUL

Corrosive

- Corrosive Hazard
 - Wear goggles
 - Read labels
 - Wear apron
 - Keep off skin



Irritant

- Irritant Hazard
 - Not corrosive, but can cause skin irritation, blisters or reddening
 - Keep away from skin/eyes
 - Wear goggles & apron
 - Read labels



Oxidizing

- Oxidizing Hazard
 - Provide oxygen to allow materials to burn easier
 - Keep away from fire
 - Wear goggles
 - Read label



Others (we will not use)

- Biohazard
 - Wear gloves
 - Avoid all bodily contact
 - Dispose of materials properly

EXPLOSIVE

Explosive Material
 – Keep away from fire
