It is hard to believe that we are already in the mix of the holidays; seems like the school year just started! Report cards will be going home with students on *Friday, December 9*. Report cards will have a new look this year, as we changed over to a different reporting system. Please take time to review and go over your child's report card with him/her. This is a great learning opportunity for you and your child. The report card is another way to communicate student growth and progress during the year. At Troy School, we closely monitor how your child grows and develops from trimester to trimester. Remembering that starting strong is good; finishing strong is equally important. We, at Troy School, are all about striving to be our best! If you have any questions about your child's progress, please contact your child's teacher.

With the winter months upon us, I would like to offer a few reminders. Students spend 10-15 minutes outside in the morning, and another 30 before or after lunch, except on days when the temperature is below 19 degrees. Being dressed appropriately for the weather is EXTREMELY important. Please be sure to send your child with hats, mittens, boots, snow pants, and winter coats.



Also, please take the time to LABEL your child's items with initials or last names. If your family is experiencing difficulties during this cold season, please be in touch with the school. Children's well-being is very important to us! There are many organizations that have contacted us about providing assistance. Be assured that the conversations are confidential. Contact us if there is a need.

During the winter season, I also ask that we use extra caution when dropping students off and picking up your child. With the arrival of snow, sidewalks, drop off loop, and the parking lot may become slippery. Please be sure to slow down, look, and take a few extra minutes for the safety of everyone. If you drop your child off in the morning, please be sure to pull up as far as possible BEFORE letting students out of the car. This will help keep the line moving. The safety of our students is always our top priority! Thank you for your assistance and cooperation.
