
















New Hampshire State Testing: As previously mentioned, NH State Testing will take place during the month of May. Students in Grades 3-6 will be evaluated on their proficiencies in Language Arts and Mathematics. Additionally, fifth graders will take a Science portion to measure knowledge. While it is important to remember that data collected from these assessments assist us respond to your child's learning needs; they are one piece of information that is collected and added to "a bigger picture". During the testing period, it would be helpful to students to be present, to avoid having to makeup sessions. Additionally, a good night's sleep and a good night's sleep will assist students to perform at their best! Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions.








