He does not like the fact people talk saying they do not like the School Board and the "white house" are the enemies. It will haunt us until we all work together. He would recommend the Superintendent's office go into the MS/HS. We are improving but not there yet. We are almost at \$17,000.00 for the cost per pupil. We have reduced and cut. We are at a difficult situation. A centralized elementary school will get us there but the towns want their schools. The staff has been doing it the same way for 30 years. We need to help them change. We need to reinvent our schools. We have too many administrators in our district even with the cuts our taxpayers are not happy. We need dramatic change, from the School Board all the way down the system. We need to do something visible. He is not asking for any reaction tonight. He has given the Board 14 ideas to think about. K. Craig has restructured the department council. We have bold changes. We have a lot of noise but not a lot of music. The cost is too high here. We can get to be an outstanding District. We may have to move the administration around. He would like to invite the members of the International Center

to help work with the High School. He really wants the District to do well. We have an uphill battle and a lot of change.
