K. Wheeler was concerned with the reduction of specials in the Gilsum School. It was explained with the new plan the STEAM Academy/Gilsum will now receive Art, Music and PE 1 and 1/2 times a week. It was commented Cutler, Mt. Caesar, Troy and Emerson will receive now receive Art, Music and PE 1 and $\frac{1}{2}$ times a week. This is still not equitable. K. Pfeifer would like to make it equitable across the district. He does not believe this change will hinder the education of the students. K. Wheeler commented she does not want to take away from the program, especially when we have a committee currently looking at expanding the program. I also am concerned with making major changes anywhere, including the combining of 5th and 6th grades in Troy, just before we have a new Superintendent. J. Carnie said equity across the district is admirable but it will never be.
