Grade 4 - (Alberta) Mathematics - Wednesday, May 22nd

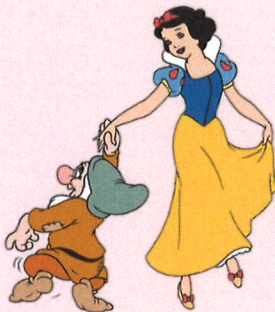

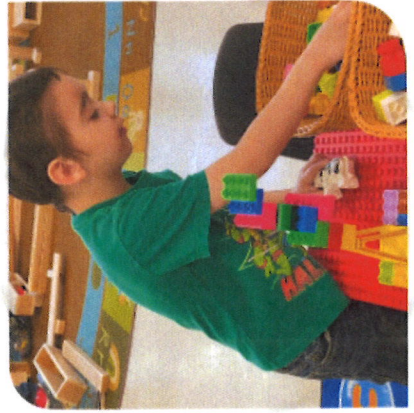

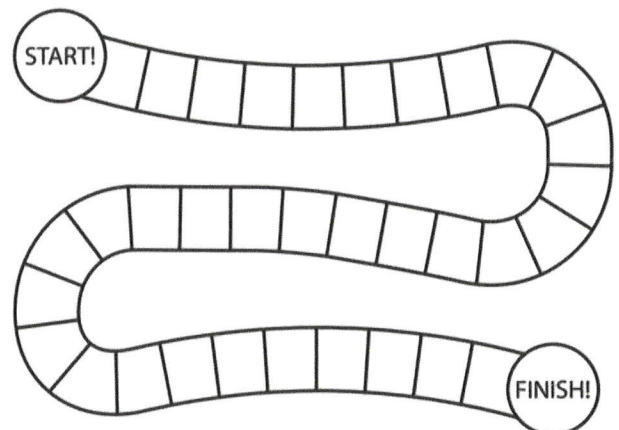


BOARD GAMES

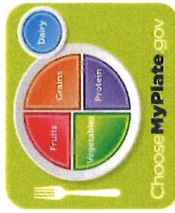

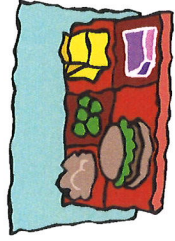

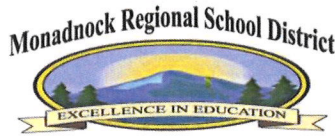
