



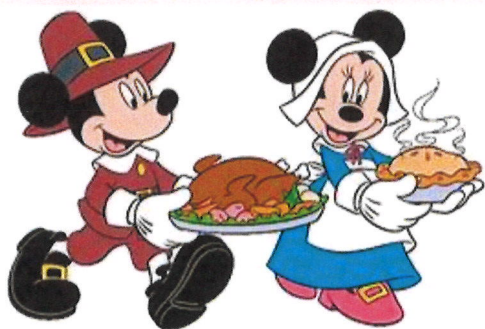

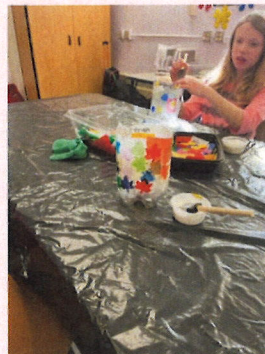
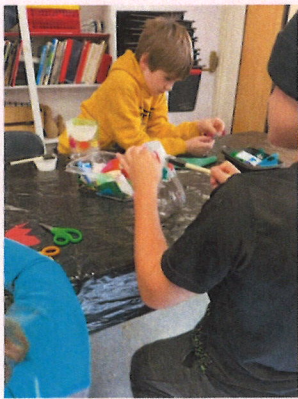
In the next months we will be exploring our databases to help students research subjects needed for classroom projects as well as high interest.

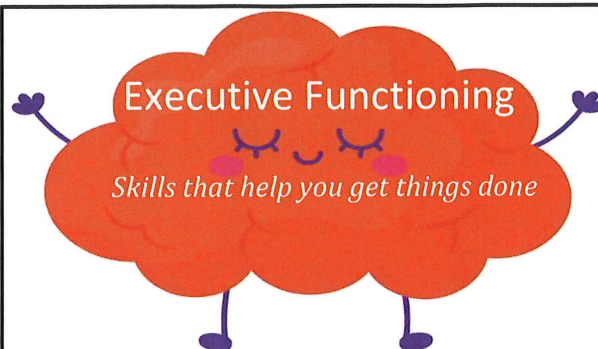

PUMPKIN PIE SMOOTHIES

Recipe adapted from tasteofhome.com

Prep/Total Time 10 minutes
Makes 4 servings

Set out a can opener, spoon, measuring cups and measuring spoons, cutting board or plate, butter knife, a blender and 4 glasses.

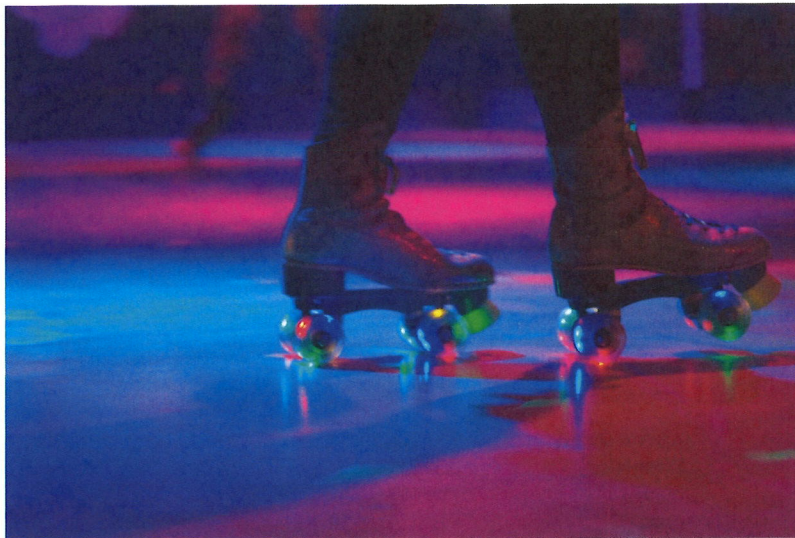
Chill in the refrigerator before starting the recipe:

- 1 can (15 ounces) pumpkin
- 1-1/3 cups evaporated milk (about 10 ounces)
- 1 cup orange juice

Add the above ingredients into the blender along with the following:

- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 small ripe banana, cut into thirds

Process all the ingredients in the blender until smooth. Pour into the glasses. Enjoy, and don't forget to wash the dishes!
